Neither Arley Moss Equestrian nor any person acting on behalf of the establishment accept any liability for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horse, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.

Any Individual Using The Facilities Within These Premises Does So At Their Own Risk

The following general rules must also be observed:

The facilities must be used in a sensible manner compatible with the level of experience of the rider and horse or pony.

Current standard riding hats (PAS015, EN1384) must be worn, unless for some specific reason a disclaimer is signed for exemption. If under 18 years, then hats must be worn for all riding.

When using the all weather gallops, hats and back protectors of current BS standards must be worn. Users must be accompanied and the tape/chain gate must be closed when using this facility.

Under 16 yrs old must be accompanied by an adult, but all are advised not to use the show jumping arena unaccompanied.

Please do not muck out lorries/trailer on the lorry park. Take all rubbish and droppings away. Please clean up droppings from the arenas before leaving. No haynets outside wagons.

Horses or ponies must not be left unattended tied to the side of wagons or trailers.

No dogs are allowed on site.

All horses must have a minimum of third party insurance.

The speed limit on site is 5mph.

Strictly no smoking on the premises, other than in the designated smoking area (as signposted).

Gates to the arenas must be closed during riding.

When using an arena consideration must be shown and given to people using surrounding arenas.

The show jumps are not to be moved, a course has been created and will be changed periodically. However the heights may be changed, to suit your requirements, but all must be put back to the preset heights when finished. You are advised not to attempt jumps above your or your horse's capability. Report any damage to jumps.

The proprietor reserves the right to close one or other of the facilities without prior notice for whatever reason. Any bookings during this time will be void.
